


1st quarter 2018



Strong families, a healthy and active population



- Quality of healthcare services one of the lowest in the EU
- Increasing need for healthcare services
- Low life expectancy
- Violence within a family
- High at risk of poverty rates of single-parent families
- Low social protection expenditure
- High income inequality
- Decrease of total population



- Healthy life years for men and women
- Preventable/treatable mortality
- Mortality due to external causes
- Children at risk of poverty rate
- Summary fertility rate



- Better access to state paid healthcare services, in particular, for those essential for mother and a child as well as those services which are substantial for treatable mortality and keeping abilities to work
- Improvement of quality and and efficiency of healthcare services
- Innovative solutions to reduce use of alcohol, tobacco and other addictive substances
- Prevention of violence and timely intervention
- Improvements for families with children, introducing adjustments of taxation policy and benefits
- Measures to help achieving balance between work life and family life



Knowledge and skills for personal and national growth

- Financing of private enterprises for **R&D** activities
- Share of 15 years old students with high performance in reading, maths and science
- Share of students in vocational education



Main tasks:

- Building of human capacity in science
- Internationalization of science and tertiary education
- Market-oriented research programmes
- Implementation of three-pillar system in tertiary education and science
- Strengthening of and access to life-long learning
- Implementation of the new education standard
- Measures to eliminate all sorts of violence



Competitiveness of companies and material welfare



- Low productivity
- Low innovation activity
- Mismatch of labour demand and supply
- Too high taxes for low wage earners
- Low level of FDI
- Slow integration of digital technologies



Indicators:

- Labour productivity per working hour
- Knowledge and technology output (GII)
- Employment
- Tax wedge
- Integration of digital technologies (DESI)



- Support for 5 sectors of smart specialization strategy
- Cooperation of scientists, entrepreneurs and state to develop new products and services
- Attraction of FDI for promotion of high added value exports
- Re-emigration and attraction of skillled workforce from abroad
- Decrease of taxe for low wage earners
- Development of capital market
- Motivation and support to start entrepreneurship



Quality living conditions and territorial development



- Capacity to develop green technologies
- Decrease of GHG emissions
- Costs of public services in areas of low population density
- Migration to development centres
- Low energy efficiency of housing
- Low entrepreneurial activity in remote areas



Indicators:

- GHG emission intensity
- Share of recycled waste
- Index of transport infrastructure
- Disparities of GDP in regions
- Share of annually renovated houses



Main tasks:

- Technology development to replace fossil fuels
- Increase of share of recycled waste
- To develop efficient public transport network
- To promote use of digital services and centralization of IT infrastructure governance
- Establishing of the Regional development fund for projects of regional scale
- Support for entrepreneurship new jobs, mobility, infrastructure
- Social housing and support for purchase of apartment to families with children



Culture and sports for active and fulfilling life



- Inactive way of life and obesity
- Unequal supply of opportunities for sports and culture
- Creative industries as generator of innovation
- Search and development of talants
- Organization of international events



Indicators:

- Share of household expenditure for culture and recreation of all household expenditure
- Share of export in value of sector of culture
- Number of attended cultural events per 100 inhabitants



- Activation of people to participate in activities of culture and sports
- Coordinated use of sports and culture infrastructure
- Preservation of cultural heritage
- Support to professional creativity in arts
- Awareness raising about Latvia by attraction of investment and consumers of cultural and sport events and services
- Search and development of new talents in sports and culture



A united, secure and open society



- Trust in others and ability to cooperate
- Participation on socially important matters
- Low satisfaction with state administration
- Slow litigation processes



Indicators:

- Share of people stating sentiment of belonging
- Society participation index
- Satisfaction with public services
- Trust in system of rights protection
- Media literacy
- Criminal cases per 10 000 inhabitants



Main tasks:

- To promote participation in NGOs
- Strengthening of the role of Latvian language
- Strengthening of media literacy and critical thinking
- Digital services finetuned for specific individual needs
- Efficient system of children rights protection
- Prevention of risks of violence
- To strengthen ability of rights protection institutions to react efficiently

Financing NDP2027

Know

Result: full information on planned projects and activities

Data collection

Ministries submit investment projects and activities planned for 2021 -2027

Projects and measures are attributed to the measures and initial sources of financing, including the state budget and the EU Multiannual Financial Framework

Prioritise

Result: ranking of projects and activities according to their effectiveness and return

Socio-economic assessment

Primarily - socio-economic and horizontal effectiveness factors Each project or activity is evaluated for purposes of comparison

Decide

Result: Financial annex with projects and activities to be supported in the following planning period

Selection of projects and measures

The ranked projects are mapped according to their funding sources, size, constraints, etc.

The result is integrated into the NDP2027 structure – under the relevant priorities, priority directions and measures
